SUGGESTED TOPICS

All theoretical and empirical studies related to these following topics are welcome in VES 2020:

- 1. Education development strategies with a focus on holistic competence development
- 2. Teaching and learning in the age of digitalization
 - a. Developing learners' competence through multi-dimensional education models.

b. Innovating teaching and learning methods through education-related sciences (e.g., neuroscience, psychological and educational sciences)

- c. Upgrading teachers' pedagogies and competencies
- d. Role of e-learning platforms and digital tools in enhancing learning outcomes
- 3. Collaboration in education: the role of communities, government, organizations, and schools.

AWARDS

- We will award travel expenses for at least five contributors from outside Hanoi. Please state in your submission if you would like to apply for that award.
- There will be two best paper awards, one for research-based papers and the other for practice-based papers selected by VES organiser.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Submissions should come in two formats: as an abstract or as a full paper.
- Your submission should include title, background, purpose of the project, theoretical foundation (optional), methods/procedure of collecting and analyzing data or evidence, a summary of findings, and implications for policy/practice.
- In case you submit a full paper (of up to 8,000 words), please follow the APA 6th style format. A practice-based paper, for example, one that reports/evaluates a community project or on-the-ground practice, should be between 2,000 and 3,000-word long.
- If your paper is accepted, you will be recommended for a suitable format to present your work at VES: a poster session, a formal presentation, or a panel session. Presentation guidelines will be provided in the notification email to you. We may also notify you of the possibility of publishing your work in one of EduNet-AVSE Global publication projects./.
